The company additionally provides full confidential reporting arrangements via nominated Managers responsible for Health & Safety. Contact numbers for confidential reporting are provided on site, and are issued as part of the briefing process.

Managers and staff are also encouraged to report any unsafe acts or conditions, which they have witnessed.
